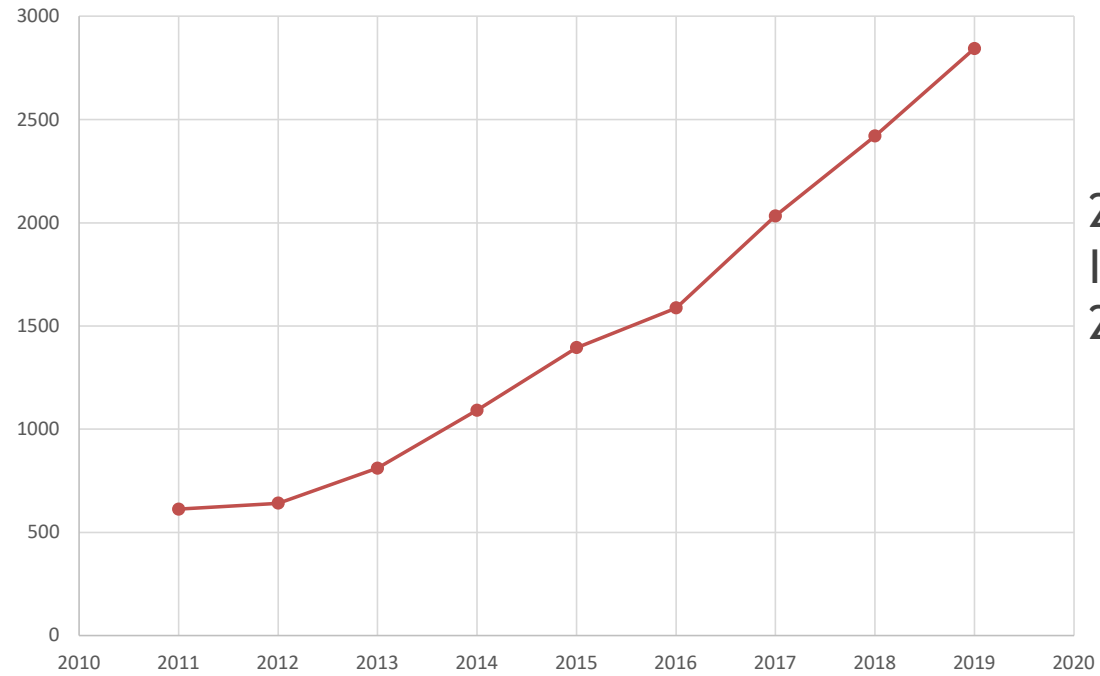
Membership Continues to Grow

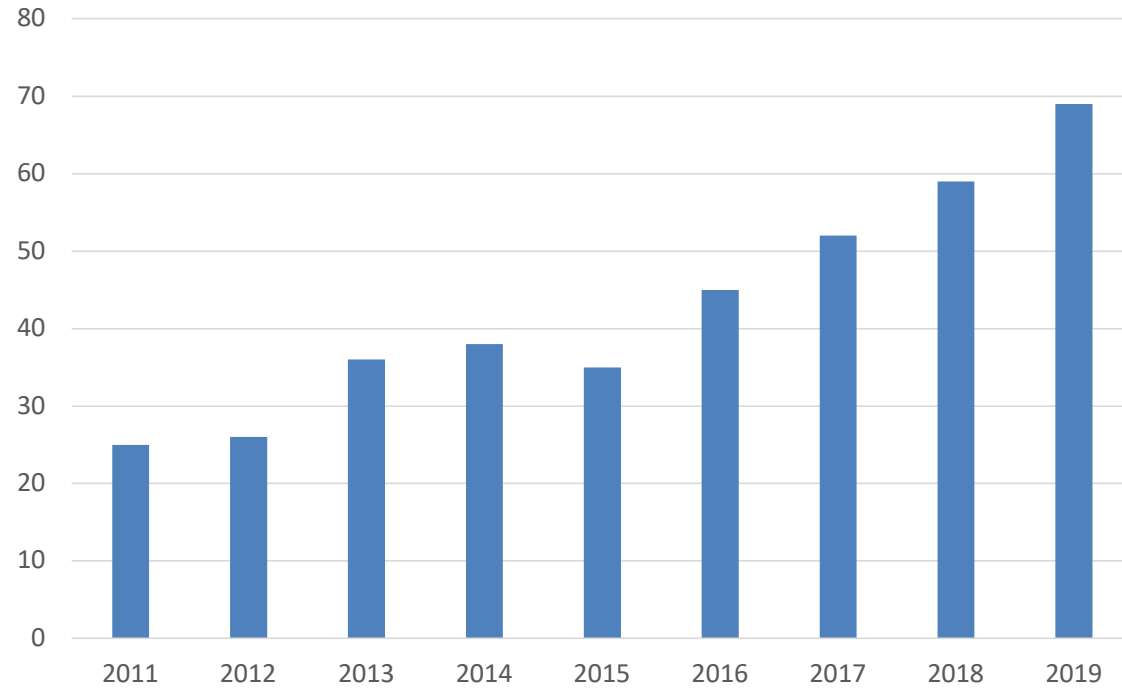

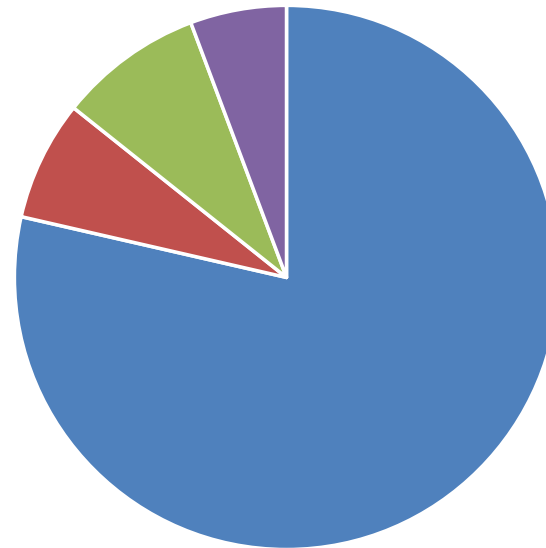


Number of Clubs

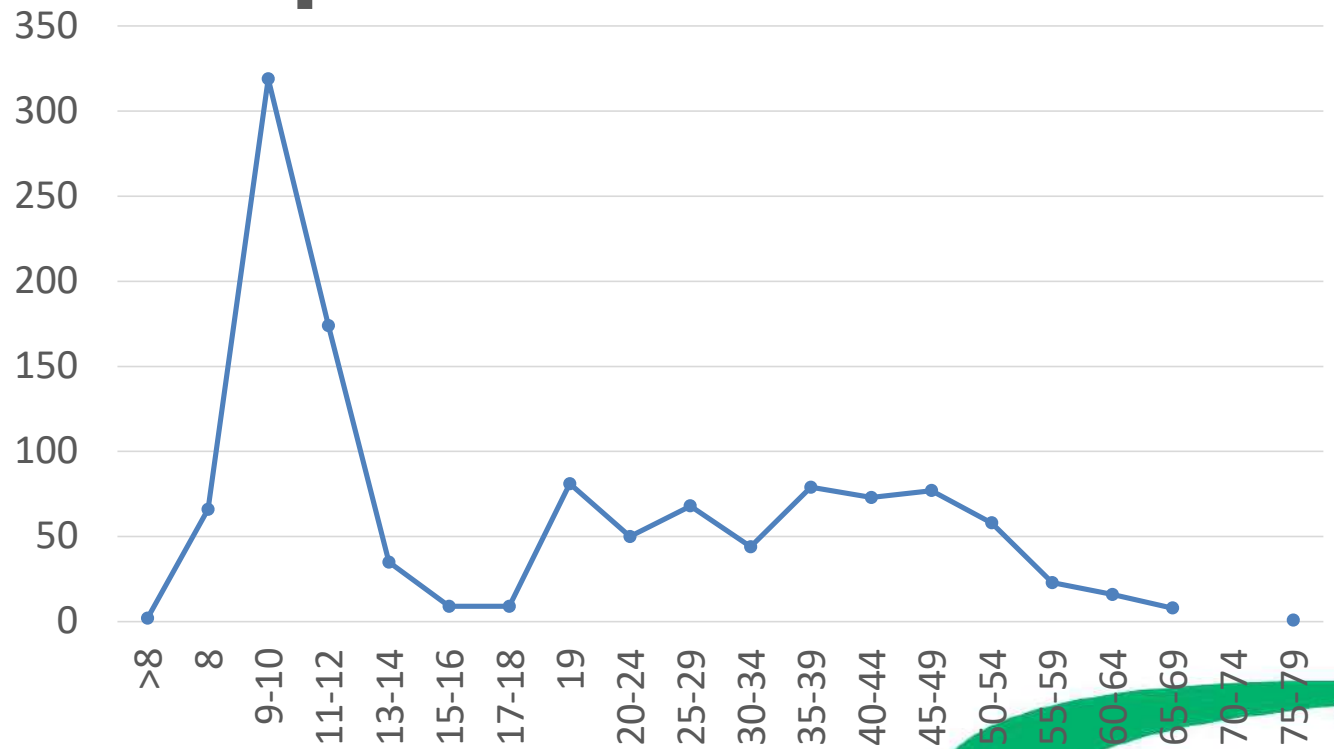

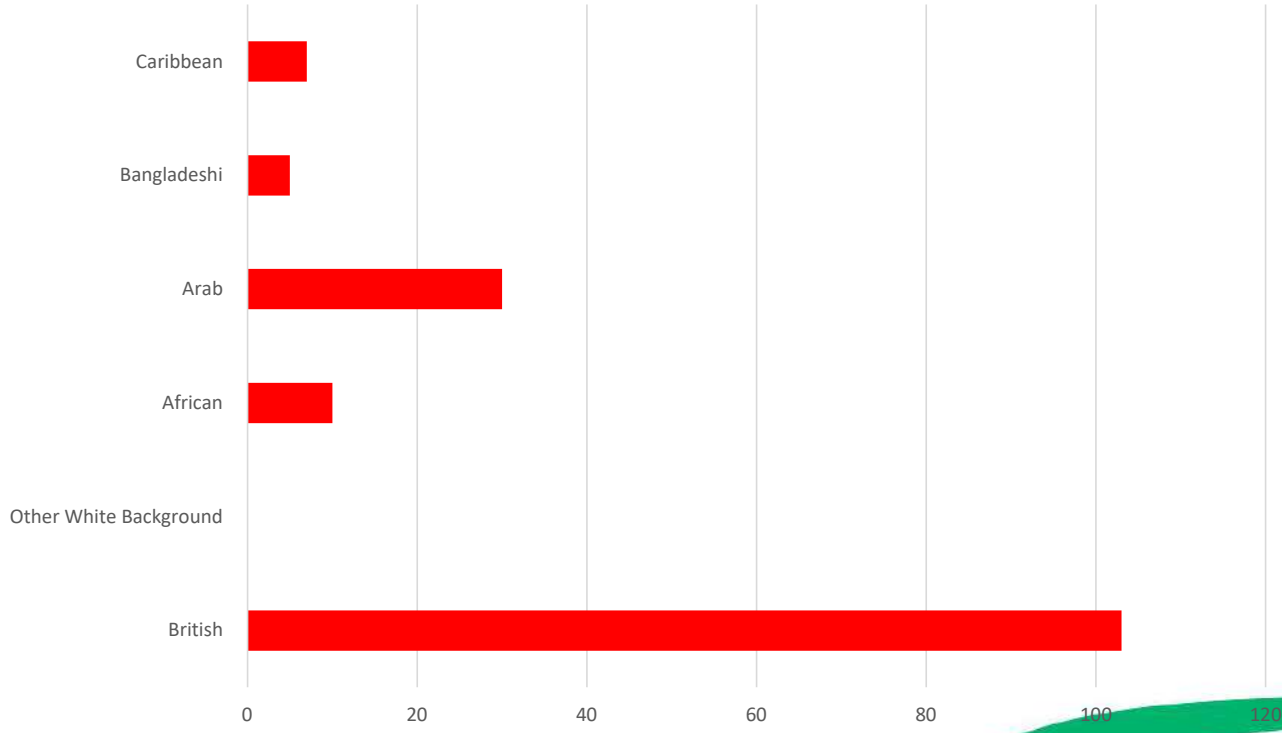


GOTRI Participation Age Group

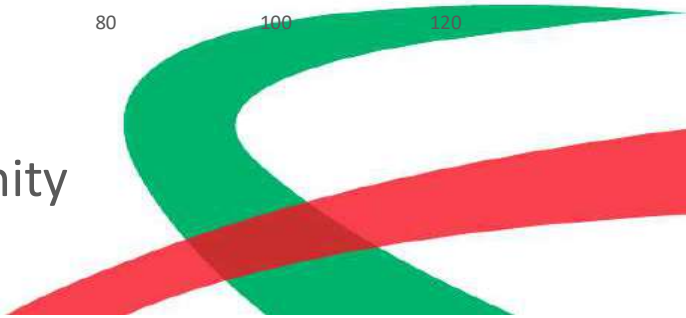

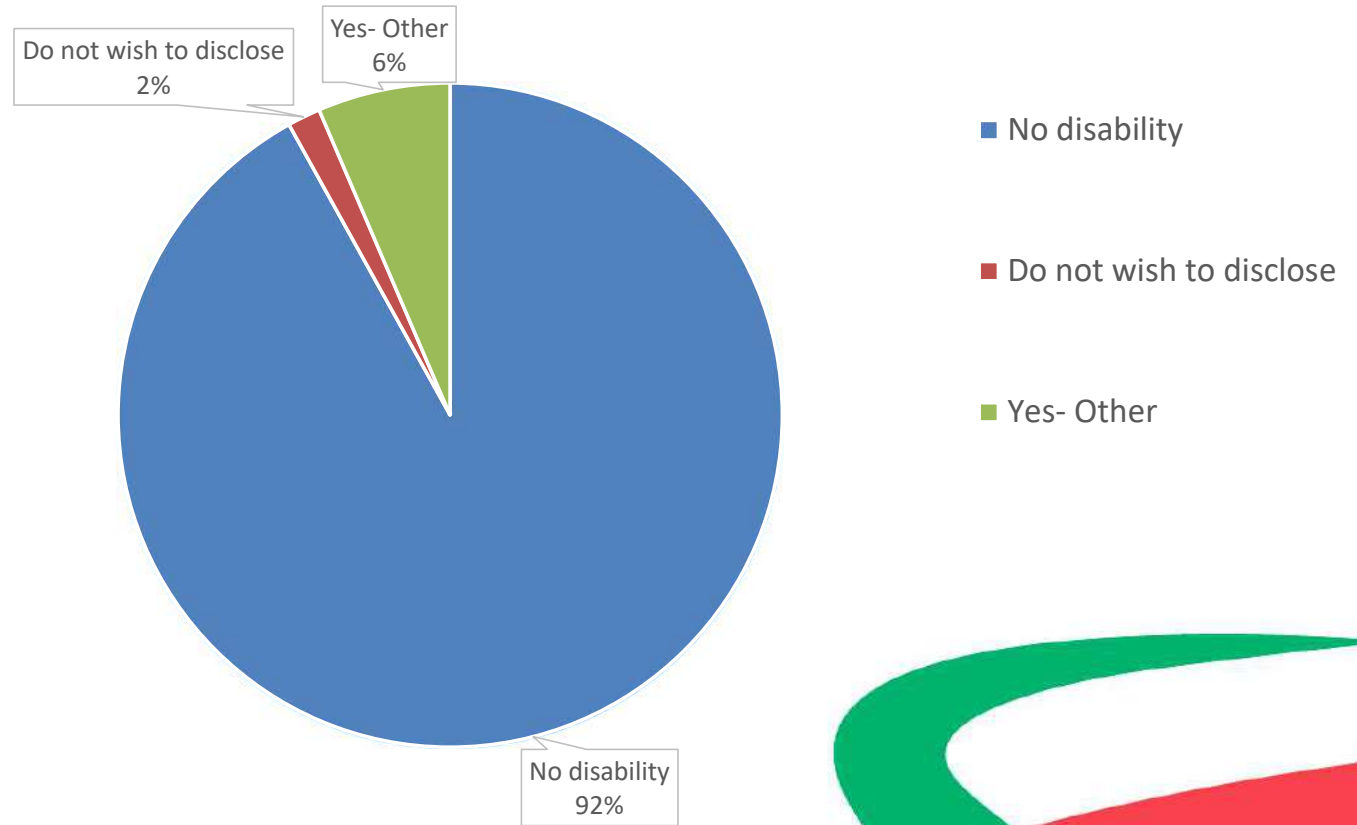

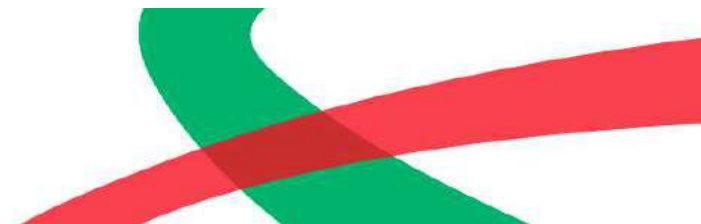
Activators



To date 68 Trained activators in Wales in 2019 (141 in total)

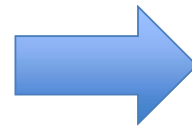
Introduced adapted courses for different audiences

Students also had an element of event volunteering bolted onto the course



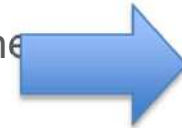
College activators helped facilitate Events in Carmarthenshire - FE college duathlon and Schools GOTRI

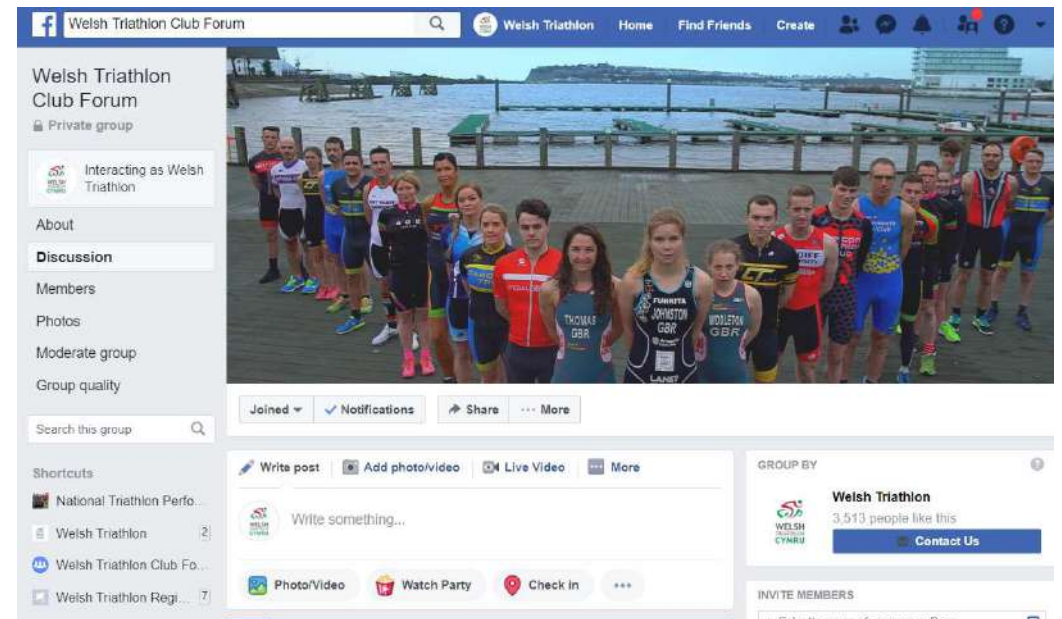
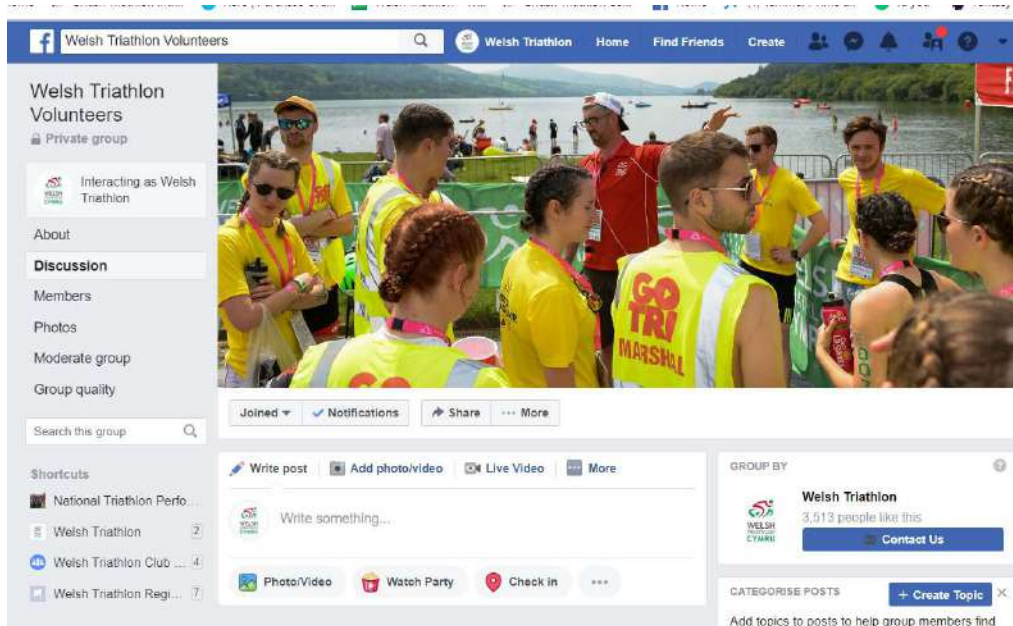
Volunteer surveys – post event surveys to see what the volunteers thought of their experience

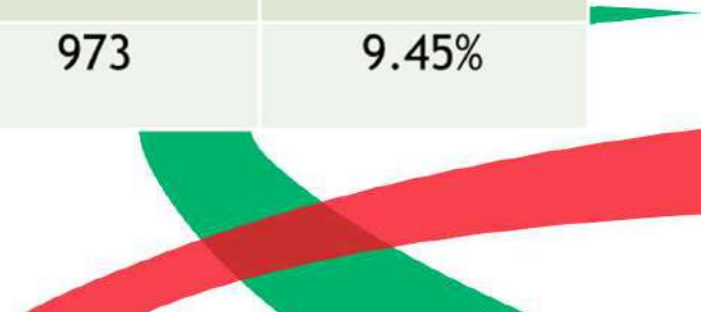
